I was introduced to your MAGIC WINDOW product line at the L.A. Home and Remodeling show during the time my wife and I were in the process of remodeling our Kitchen.

I purchased a Casement Style MAGIC WINDOW, and a Slider Style window for my kitchen. I did not replace all of the windows in my home, but was secure in the knowledge that the remaining windows would suffice since they had wrought iron security bars covering them.

Both windows were professionally installed and added great beauty to both the inside and outside of my residence. I did not reinstall the wrought iron bars because of the great beauty and aesthetics the MAGIC WINDOWS provided.

Recently, my home was burglarized (Jan. 28, 2004) and the thieves ransacked my belongings and stole some of my most valuable possessions. My privacy was violated and the security of my family was in question.

The only positive aspect of the ordeal, was that the thieves were not able to gain access through the MAGIC WINDOWS. Instead, they ripped the wrought iron security bars from the frame of an adjacent window. They destroyed that old window, and also damaged the surrounding exterior finish/trim.

Evidence showed that the thieves initially tried to pry and break the MAGIC WINDOWS using a spade shovel and a gardening hoe. They attempted entry through the MAGIC WINDOWS, because they did not have the security bars. Being unsuccessful in their efforts to open or break the MAGIC WINDOWS, they went to a secondary choice, which was a window with the security bars. The security bars did not provide any deterrent to the burglar.

I am now in the process of having my remaining windows replaced, using the MAGIC WINDOWS' product line.
